SIRE LINE

Every few decades a stallion seems to come along that changes the game. In recent history there have only been a select few, and you can't have that conversation without bringing up Sweet Lou. After a famed career with the Burke Brigade that saw him take a 1:47f record and earn nearly \$3.5 million, Sweet Lou entered the breeding shed. To say he has excelled would be an understatement. With seven crops of racing age, Sweet Lou has sired the winners of over \$70 million. He's the sire of seven different million dollar winners, with several more active offspring nearing that mark. Sires naturally fall out of favor as years pass, but amazingly Sweet Lou has bucked that trend, breeding his best books of mares in the most recent seasons with a rising stud fee. Perhaps one of the strongest advantages for a dominant sire that Sweet Lou possesses is his outcross sire line. A son of Yankee Cruiser, Sweet Lou has shown he can excel with nearly any maternal cross. The "Great White Blaze" has changed the game and Loubet will follow in his huge hoofprints in Indiana!

MATERNAL LINE

It takes the complete package to produce a sire in today's market. Loubet's maternal line consistently shows one thing. Raw Speed! Although not a noted performer, Loubet's third dam Armbro Nashville is a mare that has certainly left her mark on the sport. The daughter of Big Towner produced 12 foals, with 10 being winners. That list is topped by million dollar winner and sire Allamerican Native. Another is \$500,000 winner Allamerican Nadia, who is responsible for the most successful leg of this maternal family, and who is also Loubet's second dam. She sits with 8 foals, 7 winners, led by the high speed horse Apprentice Hanover, a multiple stakes winner of nearly \$1 million. To cap all of it off, Loubet's dam is a daughter of Rocknroll Hanover. Sweet Lou has clearly shown some of his best offspring are bred on this cross.





"I was as excited about Loubet as a 3 year old as I've ever been with any horse. He won his last race at 2 (the 2022 Kindergarten) in 1:49.3, last quarter in :25.3. He's got a different gear, he's special, but unfortunately fought injuries at 3. In a 3 year old class dominated by Sweet Lou's, I truly believe he was capable of being at the top.
